




Thanks to the consistent generosity of the donors, CWF continues to grow each year and make a difference in the lives of hundreds of thousands of people.




#### **Project Highlights-2018**














#### Health Care (\$86,372,95):

Healthcare is one of the most important areas of focused attention for Charity Way Foundation. Under this project cataract eye surgery in India and care for thalassemia patients in Pakistan are major works undertaken. Free medical clinics operate in both these countries.

#### **India**

Cataract eye surgery is one of the oldest and successful programs of the foundation in India. Since a large number of people lose their eye sights due to negligence and financial challenges, we conduct free health check- up camps and cataract eye surgeries in the villages of Bihar. In 2018, we organized 9 health check-up camps in the villages of Roh, Baksauti, Sardala, Rajauli, Kumhrawan, Moghlakhar, Rasul Nagar, Kawakol and Bihar Sharif attended by more than 2000 people. It resulted in the cataract and related eye surgeries of more than 410 patients with all free facilities.

In the old city area of Bihar capital Patna, a medical clinic by the name of Shifa Health Centre has been successfully running since 2006 to provide basic medical care to the population living in the surrounding area. In this clinic, **1331** patients were treated at the cost of **\$4.42** per patient with free basic medications.

A dental chair was donated in the Maulana Sajjad Memorial Hospital of Imarat Shariah, Phulwari Sharif in Patna.

Other medical assistance and needs were provided to more than **50** other patients in the states of Bihar and Jharkhand.

#### **Pakistan**

In the large cities like Karachi, urban poverty is visible in many areas which directly impacts health of residents. To meet this challenge four permanent medical clinics are sponsored by CWF at Sachal Goth, Lasi Para, Goth Dhani



Baksh and Kamran Chaurangi. In the year 2018, these clinics together provided health care to more than **1,26,085** patients at the cost of **\$0.95** per patient. These clinics provide **95%** of all medication free of cost to their patients. Medical laboratory service to these clinics have also made life of patients easy.

Jamila Sultana kidney screening program is supported by CWF. A total of **632** patients were screened last year under this program. Patients with renal problems were referred for further evaluation. Early stage screening and referral checks further damage to the kidney.

Afzal Memorial Thalassemia Foundation (AMTF) hospital was provided last year a few laboratory equipments like cerofuge, coagulation analyzer, high speed centrifuge machine and portable X-ray. Cerofuge is the mandatory equipment in a blood bank which is used for patient blood grouping, cross matching, screening for red cell antibodies and phenotyping and multiple purpose including serology test. Coagulation analyzer is used for monitoring of bleeding disorders in patients with Thalassemia, Hemophilia, Thromboembolism and related other medical conditions. Timely detection prevents bleeding and hemorrhage through immediate treatment. High speed centrifuge machine in the biochemistry department helps in analyzing chemical imbalance in patients. Portable X-ray is an essential equipment in the hospital used for emergency x-ray for patients having problem in movement and transportation or where patient is so sick to be moved.

Under breast cancer support program, **15** patients were treated last year by the collaboration of CWF and AMTF. The main focus of the program is to provide timely and quality treatment to women of age group **30** to **60** years especially young mothers diagnosed with this disease.

Last year two dialysis patients were supported for the entire year.



#### Education (\$46,349.43)

We at Charity Way Foundation strongly believes that education empowers everyone. With this thought we are running schools, supporting maktabs and motivating teachers to perform efficiently.

We started a school named An-Noor English School at Kawakol in the Nawada district of Bihar in the year 2008 for modern education to the financially challenged neighborhood population. Bringing high quality education in a village is not an easy task due to challenges in resource mobilization. It has an enrolment of about **450** students with **23** teachers. We run this school from playgroup to grade 8. It has computer and projector which are used by teacher and students for teaching and learning different subjects. School provides transport service to students residing at distant locations as well. We have well lit and ventilated classrooms with all amenities like clean drinking water, toilets for boys and girls. Last year we organized excursion trip of students historical places of Pawapuri, Nalanda University ruins and ancient capital town of Rajgeer. Towards environmental protection initiatives a rally and plantation drive was organized by the students guided by teachers.

In the campus of school a free coaching program is running since 2012 by the name of Rahbar Coaching Centre for grade 8 to 10 students admitted in the government schools. It promotes education to mainly girl students who drop out due to financial and social reasons. This centre is fully sponsored by Charity way Foundation. Total enrolment in this centre is **80** and with team of **4** teachers. In the recently declared board examination result of Grade-10 all **14** students passed it successfully.

In 1998 a free boarding school named Madarsa Islamia Darul Falah was established in the village of Phuldih which gets support from CWF. To promote exposure among its students an excursion trip was organized to



Rajgeer and Nalanda ruins. Presently **50** students are boarding in this school. Teachers' salary, food, clothing and all other expenses were supported by CWF. It provides education to more than **150** students of the surrounding areas who attends shorter duration classes every day. High performing students were awarded.

In another school named Madarsa Ishatul-Islam in Bihar Sharif, 2 orphan students are fully supported by CWF. It includes boarding, lodging and all other major and minor expenses. This school is also provided with a teacher to teach local non boarding 160 students. Last year construction work of the school has been supported by CWF.

Another school based at Masjid Hayat in Giridih is supported by CWF having **10** boarders and **1** teacher.

Forty Eight (48) Maktab schools in Jharkhand and Bihar are supported by CWF by taking care of part of teachers' salary. These schools are located in remote areas of minimal educational facility as a result of which these institutions become the only source of education for children. These schools provide basic education to more than 2,400 students.

CWF also supplied books, supporting goods and other necessary supplies to various schools in Bihar and Jharkhand.

#### Ramadan & Eid (\$115,050.34)

Charity Way Foundation organizes many programs in the holy month of Ramadan. It promotes the value of care and well being for the under privileged brothers and sisters.

In the hot summer month of Ramadan free ice distribution was started in the year 2015. It helps people to break their fast with cold soothing water. In 2018 it reached to more than **1100** families.



Ramadan package program was started in the year 2008 which supports entire family from the first day of Ramadan till Eid celebration. This program provides all the household needs during Ramadan. Such families don't need to buy even salt or matchboxes for that month. It also includes grocery for the month and the clothing for the day of Eid for an average family of four to six members. This year it helped **330** families in different parts of Bihar, Jharkhand, Tamil Nadu and Uttarakhand.

This year Sahoor and Iftar packages were distributed among **2071** families. This package contains raw material for iftar and sahoor. These packages were enough for two-person family for the whole month of Ramadan at two meals per day.

Eid package is another Ramadan program. It consists of a Chicken, Sewai, Milk and Sugar. This year it was distributed among **1400** families a day before Eid. This way they could celebrate the day of Eid. It catered to different districts of Bihar and Jharkhand.

More than **2270** families received rice and wheat from Fitra program. It was distributed in the first 10 days of Ramadan.

CWF provided **1950** women-clothing (Saries etc), **3240** Salwarsuits to young girls, **1187** men-clothing and more than **1335** children were provided Eid Clothing.

As part of full month iftar program, cooked meals were provided to the families who were fasting and having tough time to get proper food to break the fast. This year 22 families were supported under this program.

Big meal is a program of providing delicacies like Pulao, Gosht and Zarda which is used by people to have it during breaking of fast. This year we arranged **10** such meals reaching to more than **5600** people.

A day before Eid, animal Sadaqa was done that included 15 cattle to provide



meat to the families which usually don't get sumptuous meal.

Eid fairs were organized in the villages of Radhwa, Hasanpur, Phuldeeh and Kawakolof Nawada district in Bihar. It made Eid day a big day of celebration for more than **5000** children residing in these villages. It provided free food and toys for those children who are unable to celebrate the Eid day in a special way.

More than **250** families were given some monetary support few days before Eid to cover some miscellaneous needs prior to Eid.

In this month the holy Quran was distributed to **145** people.

#### **Qurbani & Sadaqa (\$52,558.34)**

Under Eidul Adha program, **122** Cattle and **165** Goats were offered for qurbani. This provided meat to approximately **4900** families. This program provides meat to some of the families who wait for the whole year to receive some meat for their families.

Sadaqa of **59** cattle provided meat for more than **2100** families and sadaqa of **75** goats provided meat for more than **770** families.

#### Housing & Construction (\$11,069.05)

Under this program houses and toilets are built as well as installation of hand pumps are undertaken.

In 2018, we helped a few families to make a good living by constructing 3 houses of two bedrooms each in the villages of Bhaluahi, Bhandari and Katihar.

We also installed **9** Hand Pumps in the villages of Bijho, Konipar, Padariya and Amarpurin the Nawada district of Bihar to provide people clean drinking water.

An independent toilet was also constructed this year in the village Padariya.



#### **Stipend & Food (\$34,976.21)**

Since a large number of people in the villages in the remote corners of India face tough financial challenges therefore stipend and food program is designed to help such disadvantaged families. Under this ration program 2-member family is supported with basic needs like rice/flour/lentil and other basic items. We are supporting more than **300** families in India and **15** families in Pakistan. It's a quarterly food distribution program supporting mainly widows, elderly and physically challenged.

Similarly, 40 students including few orphans are provided basic assistance to thrive in a school at village Deen Bandhi in the Supaul district of Bihar. It helps them get breakfast and other basic needs.

#### Mosque (\$4,827.26)

In this year **1** mosque named Masjid Taqwa was built at Bishunpur in Supaul.

Masjid Hayat built by CWF in Giridih was provided with electricity arrangement and fans.

Salaries of few mosque Imams and care takers are also taken care by us.

#### Vocational Training (\$4,771.20)

Skill development is one of the most important ways to empower young girls and women. It helps in their own development by raising their confidence level and making financially independent to support themselves and others in the family.

We are managing and upgrading **11** vocational centers for sewing in Ayub School, LohakaPul, BataoKuan, KharaKuan of Patna, one each in villages of Jana, Asthawan, Roh, Kawakol and two in PakriBarawan in Bihar and Baghadih in Jharkhand. These centers develop skills to a minimum of **300** young girls and women each year.

1 girl at village Hargawan was supported with a sewing machine to work



#### from home.

As a token of appreciation, we provide bonuses and Eid gifts to instructors and teachers which keeps them motivated to continue their good work.

#### Marriages (\$1383.12)

In 2018, CWF provided supplies like bed, trunk, wardrobe and assistance to facilitate marriages of 6 women and young girls in the villages of Giridih, Kawakol, Roh, NajalliBigha, Bijho and Korideeh.

Two teachers of An-Noor English School were presented with gifts in their marriage from CWF.

#### **Business (\$2,772.07)**

We support families capable of running small businesses. This year one such family at Bijho was supported for business of drum and steel box.

A bag factory was started in 2011 as a dream project to empower such women who used to cut tree branches in the jungle to earn a meagre amount of INR 40 to 50 per day, After joining this factory they are securely working from their homes and earning INR 100 to 175 per day. It started with 30 individuals, now it engages more than 90 individuals.

#### General (\$23,329.93)

Winter items included **2,553** blankets distributed in Phuljharia, Korideeh, Baghadeeh, Pachmoriya, Giridih villages of Jharkhand State along with village and towns of Mohni, Hargawan, Bihar Sharif, Phuldeeh and Nawada of Bihar.

In the villages of Phuljharia, Korideeh, Baghadeeh, Pachmoriya of Jharkhand **1,422** Sweaters were distributed.

Some food programs were also arranged in different areas of Bihar State.


**2** families living in Tanda forest in Uttarakhand were provided solar plates and battery for lighting in night that give protection from wild elephants.

- Ramadan programs like iftar packages, fidya, clothing, etc.
- Eidul Adha /Udhaya program.
- Small business for the families.
- Vocational training.
