CHARITY WAY FOUNDATION

Since Charity Way Foundation founding in the year 1999 as a 501 (c) (3) U.S. Tax exempt organization, it reached out to hundreds of thousands of families in India and Pakistan. In the beginning it started its operations in the states of Bihar and Jharkhand in India and Karachi town in Pakistan providing helping hands in the fields of healthcare, education, food, clothing, housing, toilet, clean drinking water, vocational training, marriage assistance, small businesses, winter clothes' distribution and many others.

COVID - 19 RELIEF

Unlike previous years, 2020 was a different year due to COVID-19 pandemic which impacted the people the world over. It brought the economic activity at the standstill. People earning their livelihood through daily wages were worst hit. They lost their employment in the big cities with no choice but to return to their villages. Those who could not return to the villages had their worst waiting time during lock down conditions. During this crises, Charity Way Foundation reached out to a large number of families in different states of India with two-month grocery.

ENHANCED GEOGRAPHICAL PRESENCE

Over the years Charity Way Foundation extended its India operations in

different districts of Bihar namely Nawada, Nalanda, Sheikhpura, Gaya, Munger, Araria and Supaul. It continued its work in the Giridih district of Jharkhand. It started working in Ghaziabad district of Uttar Pradesh and continued to work in Almora district of Uttarakhand. It began its operations in the Hyderabad district of Telangana. In Pakistan, it continued to work in Karachi.

FILLING GAPS

Charity Way Foundation always looked for opportunities to help people in need. During Hyderabad flash flood it tried to bring smile on the faces of affected families in the form of groceries. Similarly, teacher salary in Justuju school, Karachi and small businesses like stationery shop and saloon were promoted.

ROAD AHEAD

We at CWF, will continue to work in the field of healthcare by organizing medical camps, eye surgeries, general surgery, children vaccination, support to thalassemia and dialysis patients. Promoting school education and vocational training will remain the focus area to empower the youths with education. Ration program for widows and winter clothes' distribution will continue as sustained relief efforts.








COVID-19 RELIEF

COVID-19 pandemic impacted the communities, the world over. Charity Way Foundation worked in the Indian states of Bihar, Jharkhand, Telangana, Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand to provide relief materials in the form of two month- groceries to the families impacted due to loss of livelihood. More than **10,000** families were supported.

In Bihar **6942** families in Nawada, Sheikhpura, Gaya, Nalanda districts and Giridih district of Jharkhand were provided. In Munger and Araria districts of Bihar **1060** families were provided. In Ghaziabad district of Uttar Pradesh, **1375** families were provided. In Hyderabad of Telangana state **961** families were provided. In Almora district of Uttarakhand **52** families were provided.

HEALTH CARE

India

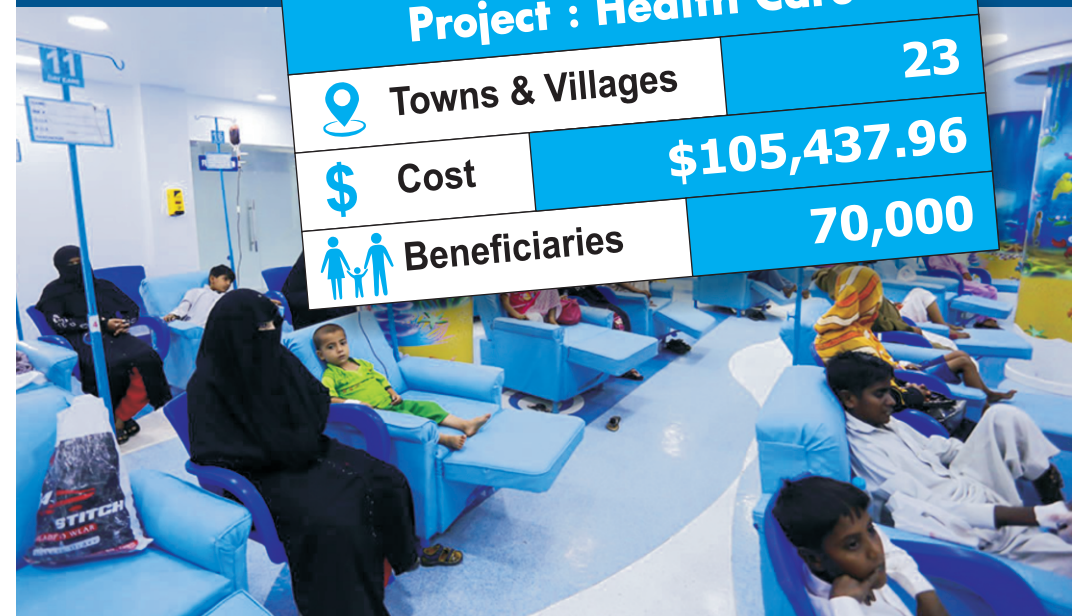
Cataract eye surgery is one of the oldest and successful programs of CWF in India. In 2020, we organized **10** health check-up camps in the villages of Nawada and Nalanda attended by more than **2000** people. It resulted in the cataract and related eye surgeries of more than **476** patients of age range of **14 to 75** years with all free facilities.




We run a medical clinic by the name of Shifa Health Centre in Patna City to provide basic medical care to the population living in the surrounding area. This year, more than **1400** patients were treated in this clinic. We had circumcision program for **254** children at Nawada. Other medical assistance and needs were provided to more than **10** other patients in the states of Bihar and Jharkhand.

Pakistan

In Karachi, four permanent medical clinics are sponsored by CWF. In the year 2020, these clinics together provided health care to more than **65,656** patients at the cost of **\$0.50** per patient. These clinics provide 95% of all medication free of cost to their patients.

Jamila Sultana kidney screening program is supported by CWF. Early stage screening and referral checks further damage to the kidney. We support Afzal Memorial Thalassaemia Foundation (AMTF) hospital in multiple ways. This year, **12** cancer patients received treatment in the form of chemotherapy and medication.

EDUCATION

We, at Charity Way Foundation strongly believe that education empowers everyone. An-Noor English School at Kawakol in the Nawada district of Bihar was established in 2008 for modern education to the financially challenged neighborhood children. With an enrolment of about **450** students with **23** staff this school runs from playgroup to grade **8**. In 2020, during lockdown condition, worksheets were sent to students to Continue their learning.

In the campus of school, a free coaching program sponsored by CWF is running since 2012 by the name of Rahbar Coaching Centre for grade **8** to **10** students admitted in the government schools. It promotes education to mainly girl students who drops out from schools due to

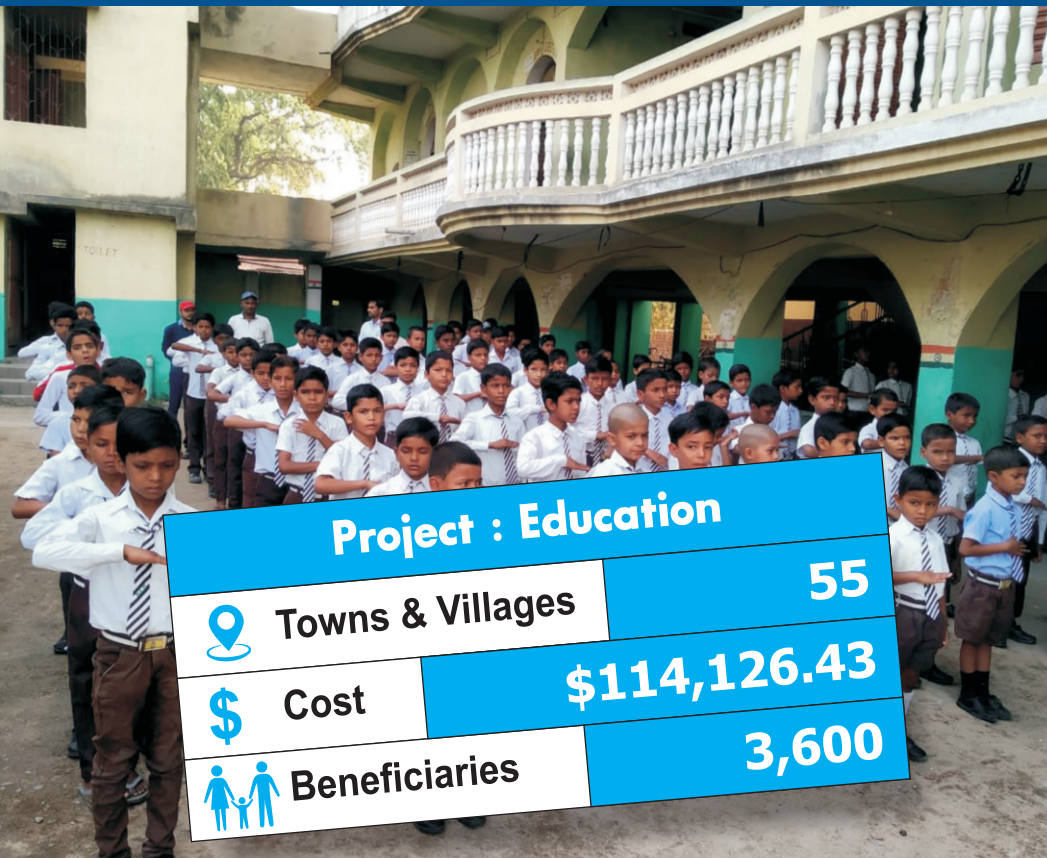


financial and social reasons. Total enrolment in this center is **80** with a team of **4** teachers.

In 1998 a free boarding school named Madarsa Islamia Darul Falah was established in the village of Phuldeeh which gets support from CWF. Presently **50** students are boarding in this school. Teachers' salary, food, clothing and all other expenses are supported by CWF. It provides education to more than **150** students of the nearby areas who attends shorter duration classes every day. Another school named Madarsa Ishate-Islam in Bihar Sharif is supported with teacher and students' sponsorship. It benefits more than **160** students. Another school based at Masjid Hayat in Giridih is supported by CWF having **10** boarders and **1** teacher.

Forty-Eight (**48**) Maktab schools in Jharkhand and Bihar are supported by CWF by taking care of part of teachers' salary. These schools provide basic education to more than **2,400** students. CWF also supplied books, supporting goods and other necessary supplies to various schools in Bihar and Jharkhand. In 2020, bonus was awarded to more than **85** teachers and other staffs of schools in Jharkhand and Bihar states. This surprise encourages them to improve overall school performance.

In Karachi, 'The Justuju School' is supported with teacher salary, rent of the building and other expenses for deprived students.

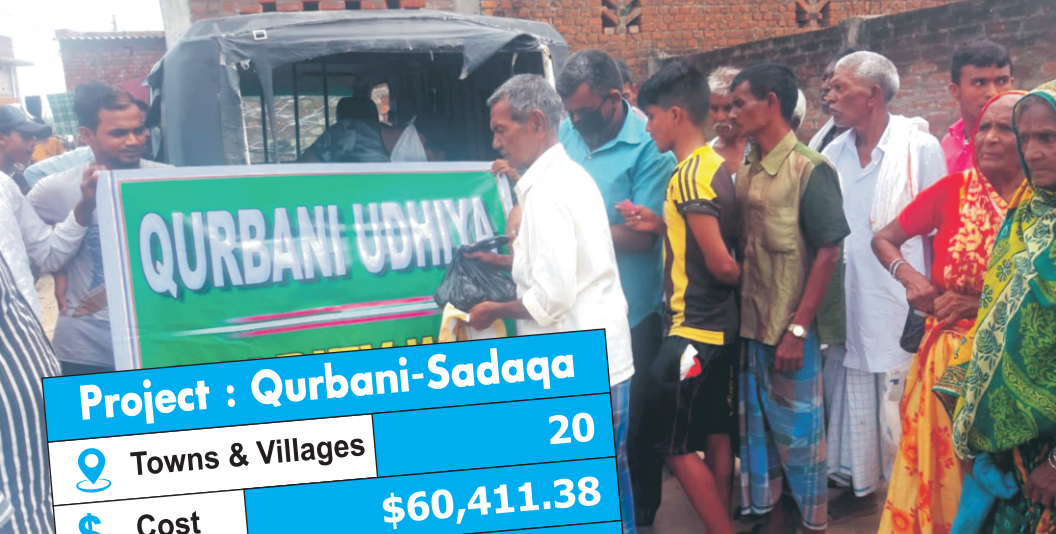

HOUSING

This year **4** Houses were built in villages of Amarpur, Akauna and Badipali in Nawada District. These are all 100% permanent concrete houses with all basic facilities.

We also constructed **9** Bathrooms in the houses of families having more female, it helps them to not go to the field in early morning of dark time to fulfill the need of nature. **9** Houses were facilitated with hand pump water facility. So, there is no need to go to fetch water from distance.

In the year 2020, **159** Cattle and **160** Goats were offered for qurbani. This provided meat to approximately **7900** families. It included qurbani in Aurangi town, Karachi in a new way. The families received one cattle each to enjoy the Eid feast. Here, **66** families were benefitted.

STIPEND

Under this ration program **2**-member family is supported with basic needs like rice/flour/lentil and other basic items. We are supporting more than **300** families in India and **3** families in Pakistan. It's a quarterly food distribution program supporting mainly widows, elderly and physically challenged. Similarly, forty (**40**) students including few orphans are provided basic assistance to thrive in a school at village Deenbandhi in the Supaul district of Bihar.

RAMADAN-EID

Ramadan package program was started in the year 2008 which supports entire family from the first day of Ramadan till Eid celebration. It also includes grocery for the month and the clothing for the day of Eid for an average family of **4 to 6** members. This year it helped **42** families in different parts of Bihar, Jharkhand and Uttarakhand.

Big meal is a program of providing delicacies like Pulao, Gosht and Zarda which is used by people during breaking of fast. In 2020 we arranged **8** such meals reaching out to more than **4200** people. A day before Eid, animal Sadaqa was done that included **10** cattle to provide meat to the families which usually don't get sumptuous meal.

Eid was a big day of celebration for more than **1122** families in Nawada. Additionally, **150** families were provided with taraza, baqarkhani, lachcha & doodh. More than **250** families were given some monetary support few days before Eid to cover some miscellaneous needs.

VOCATIONAL TRAINING

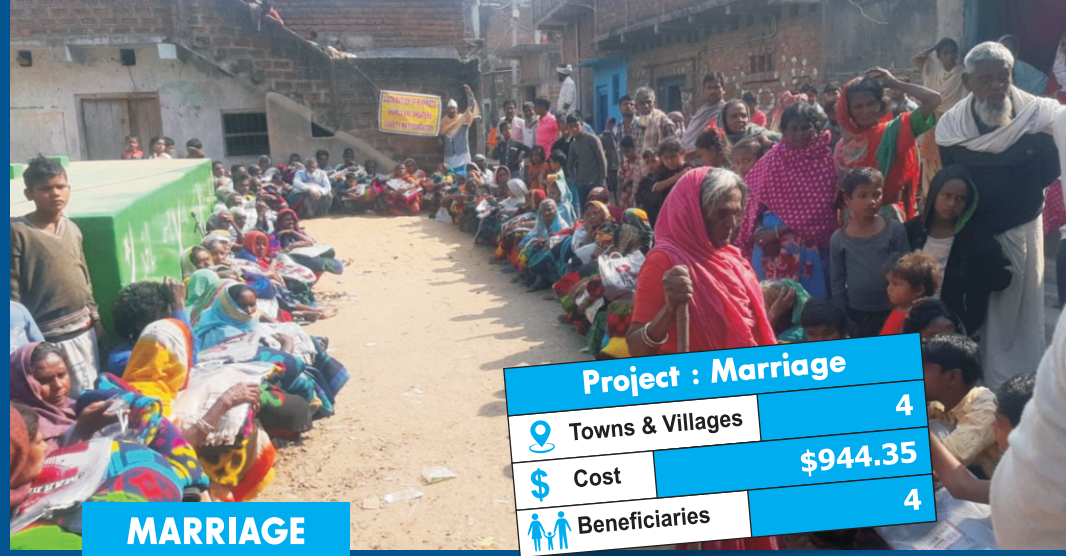
Skill development is one of the most important ways to empower young girls and women. It helps in their own development by raising their confidence level and making financially independent to support themselves and others in the family.

We are managing and upgrading **11** vocational centers of sewing which develop skills to a minimum of **300** young girls and women each year. This year a few students received sewing machines to make the earnings.

As a token of appreciation, we provide bonuses and Eid gifts to instructors and teachers which keeps them motivated to continue their good work.

We support a bag factory to empower women who used to cut tree branches in the jungle to earn an amount of INR 40 to 50 per day, After joining this factory they are securely working from their homes and earning INR 100 to 175 per day. It started with **30** individuals, now it engages more than **90** individuals. This year **1** Stationery and **1** Hair Saloon businesses were supported in Karachi.

- Relief in disasters like fire, flood or earthquakes.
- Build/renovate and provide facilities to mosques.
- Ramadan programs like iftar packages, fidya, clothing, etc.
- Eidul Adha /Udhaya program.
- Small businesses for the families.
- Vocational training.
